

3.1 financial report for the 2021-2022 school year presented by Marco. Projections on what we will collect and spend for next school year. Objective is to spend it all each year.

Based on registration of \sim 450 students on April numbers, but can be adjusted if large difference on Sept. 30th.

Since we are returning to the renovated building, can anticipate less expenses in maintenance and repair. Much of caretaking budget is in snow removal.

Presents a balanced budget with exception of rollover from GB and PPO.

Moved by Veronique, seconded by Nicholas. 6 approved.

3.2 Grad Scholarships on behalf of GB
Last year purchased 2x \$50 gift certificates for graduating students from Chapters/Indigo.
Could be from a smaller store e.g. Drawn and Quarterly.
Over \$900 in GB budget now because of rollover from past years; no refreshments needed for virtual meetings.

It has been a community service award done by teacher recommendation.

List of current awards include 2 effort awards per classroom, but they are not monetary. Discussion about what kind of awards are missing e.g activism. Can pursue next year.

Suggestion to offer 2 awards per campus based on previous criteria. Kathleen moved, Christine seconded. 6 approved.
