Dear Students and Parents,

Your decision to register for an Advanced Placement at Westmount High demonstrates that you see academic challenges as opportunities to prepare for future success. Now is the time to take the next step.

<u>New this year:</u> Advanced Placement exams will be administered digitally on <u>personal devices</u> of the types stated on the College Board's website and using the digital testing software application, Bluebook. Before ordering exams, take the following steps to verify that you are able to meet the testing requirements.

The next step in registering for an AP exam is to join your teacher's AP Classroom.

- Determine which exams you wish to order and verify the testing format (digital, paper, or hybrid). Acquire
 at least one reliable device that is approved for AP digital exam testing and verify that your device(s) meet
 the requires for testing by visiting <u>https://apcentral.collegeboard.org/exam-administration-orderingscores/digital-ap-exams/28-exams-digital-2025</u>
 - Download the Bluebook software testing application to the device you will use for your exam(s). You will need to create a College Board account to complete this step: https://myap.collegeboard.org/login
 - External students will be <u>required</u> to test the compatibility of their device(s) at Westmount High School well before the exam period to ensure access to the school's wireless network. Please check your email inbox often for an invitation to participate in this process.
- Complete the AP Exam Order Form, Conflict of Interest Disclaimer, and submit these with exam fees to the WHS Administration office before Wednesday, November 6th. Fees can be paid using cash/debit/credit; no personal cheques will be accepted.
- 3. Apply the Join Code you will receive from the AP Coordinator by email. Once you apply the join code, you will finalize your AP exam order.
- Optional: View the College Board's subject-specific AP Exam video playlists on YouTube to help you prepare. Sincerely,
