

His parents were George Harding McCormick and Isobel Richardson McCormick.


He was killed in action on July 8th, 1944 at the age of 29.

He served in Highland Light Infantry of Canada R.C.I.C.

He was buried in BENY-SUR-MER CANADIAN WAR CEMETERY, REVIERS located in Calvados. France.



He was killed on the battlefield in the Operation Charnwood that took place in France during the Battle for Caen, which was a part of the larger Operation Overload(code name for the Battle of Normandy).
