
Kenneth Pedley Pyper

Pyper was a graduate of Westmount High School in Quebec, Canada in 1934. He was very involved at his high school as a member of the football, basketball, hockey, life saving, and gym teams. He attended college for one year as an arts major. He later attended Bishops University. Kenneth enlisted with the Royal Montreal Regiment R.C.I.C, receiving the rank lieutenant. Kenneth's life was tragically cut short in an automotive accident on the 18th of November 1940. Had he been alive to see it, he would have joined his brothers in arms in the liberation of France and the assault on the Rhine as an officer of the Royal Montreal Regiment. He was buried in Brookwood Military cemetery, Surrey England (grave reference 3.Q.S).
