## What is Special Smiles?

Special Smiles provides comprehensive oral health care information, including free dental screenings and instruction on correct brushing and flossing techniques to participating Special Olympics athletes and people with an Intellectual Disability. Participants are also provided with free preventative supplies like toothpaste and toothbrushes. **Dentists, Dental Hygienists, Dental Students and Dental Hygiene Students are eligible to apply.**
