THIS APPLICATION, made by the Applicant for an Order directing the Respondent to comply with the Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991 and the Dentistry Act, 1991 and as further particularized in the Notice of Application, was heard this day at Toronto, Ontario.

ON READING the Application Record and the Consent of the parties, filed, respondent in attendance but unrepresented by Counsel.

- 1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Respondent, AHMAD HASSOUN, complies with sections 4 and 9 of the Dentistry Act and sections 27, 30 and 33 of the Regulated Health Professions Act, and in particular, that the Respondent refrain from the following, until such time if and when he becomes a licensed member of the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario:
  - (i) from using the title "dentist" or "dental surgeon" or a variation, abbreviation or equivalent in English or any other language in the course of providing or offering to provide, in Ontario, health care to individuals;
  - (ii) from using the title "doctor" or a variation, abbreviation or equivalent in English or any other language in the course of providing or offering to provide in Ontario health care to individuals;
  - (iii) from holding himself out as a person who is qualified to practise in Ontario as a dentist or in a specialty of dentistry;
  - (iii) from performing any controlled acts including but not limited to:
    - (a) performing procedures on tissues below the dermis, below the surface of a mucus membrane, in or below the surfaces of teeth, including the scaling of teeth;
    - (b) administering substances by injection or inhalation;
    - (c) communicating to individuals or his or her personal representatives a diagnosis identifying any disease or disorder as the cause of symptoms of the individual in circumstances in which it is reasonably foreseeable that the individual or his or her personal representative will rely on the diagnosis;
    - (d) from prescribing, dispensing or selling any medication or drugs of any nature or kind;

- (iv) from treating or advising a person with respect to his or her health in circumstances where it is reasonably foreseeable that serious bodily harm may result from the treatment or advice or from an omission from them.
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that there be no costs payable in respect of this Order.
