- THIS COURT ORDERS that the Motion requesting an Order finding the Respondent in contempt of the Order of Lederer J. is adjourned on consent to March 10, 2021;
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS that, until the return of the Motion, the Respondent will not practice dentistry within the terms of the Order of Lederer J. dated January 3, 2017, as follows:
  - 1. The Respondent, Ina Navitskaya, is to comply with s. 9 of the *Dentistry*Act and s.27 and s. 33 of the Regulated Health Professions Act and, in

particular, that the Respondent be and is hereby prohibited, unless or until such time as the Respondent is registered to practise dentistry in the Province of Ontario:

- From using the title "Dentist" or "Dental Surgeon" or a variation, abbreviation or equivalent in English or any other language, in Ontario;
- ii. From holding herself out as a person who is qualified to practice in Ontario as a dentist or a specialty of dentistry;
- iii. From performing any controlled acts in Ontario, in relation to dentistry including but not limited to:
  - (a) performing procedures on tissue below the dermis, below the surface of the mucous membrane, in or below the surfaces of teeth, including the scaling of teeth:
  - (b) administering substances by injection and inhalation;
  - (c) communicating to individuals or their personal representatives a diagnosis identifying any disease or disorder as a cause of symptoms in the individual and circumstances in which it is reasonably foreseeable that the individual or his/ her personal representative would rely on the diagnosis; and
  - (d) dispensing of any medication or drugs of any nature of kind.

- 3. THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Respondent remove and dispose of the dental equipment and furnishings located at 32 Boyne Highland Crt., Vaughan, Ontario, and she provide proof to counsel for the Respondent that such dental equipment and furnishings have been removed and disposed of, within 45 days of this Order;
- 4. Costs of this Motion for an adjournment shall be reserved to the Court hearing the Motion for contempt of the Order of Lederer J.
