1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Respondent, Omar Anwar, comply with section 9 of the *Dentistry Act* and sections 27 and 33 of the *Regulated Health Professions Act*, and in particular, that the Respondent be and is hereby

prohibited, unless or until such time as the Respondent is registered to practice dentistry in the Province of Ontario:

- (i) from using the title "dentist", "dental surgeon", "oral surgeon" or "DDS", or "dental" a variation, abbreviation or equivalent in English or any other language, in Ontario;
- (ii) from holding himself out as a person who is qualified to practice in Ontario as a dentist or in a speciality of dentistry;
- (iii) from performing any controlled acts in Ontario, in relation to dentistry including but not limited to:
 - (a) performing procedures on tissues below the dermis, or below the surface of a mucus membrane, or in or below the surfaces of teeth, including the scaling of teeth;
 - (b) administering substances by injection or inhalation;
 - (c) communicating to individuals or their personal representatives a diagnosis identifying any disease or disorder as a cause of symptoms of the individual and circumstances in which it is reasonably foreseeable that the individual or his or her personal representative will rely on the diagnosis; and
 - ★ (d) dispensing any medication or drugs or any nature or kind.
- 2. THIS COURT ORDERS costs payable by the Respondent respect of this Application in the amount of \$\(\frac{2}{500}\)\cdot\(\infty\) plus HST.
